PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MINUTES THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2013 AT 2:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER

At 2:11 p.m. Chairman Kerman called the meeting to order at the Village Hall.

AGENDA ITEMS

1) Food Service Establishment (FSE) Ordinance

Administrator Masciola gave an account of the February 2011 Sanitary Sewer Line ductile iron pipe failure caused by hydrogen sulfide gas and low flow rates. The Village of Streamwood allowed South Barrington to pump into their sanitary sewer while the repair was being made. The Village has since relined certain sections.

Engineer Grieves said Village restaurants need to be more diligent with best management practices, grease removal and pretreatment of water with high sulfate levels which convert to sulfide gas when in contact with oxygen. A normal level would be 50 mg/l.

Ms. Bouchard answered questions and the Committee discussed certain points of the draft FSE Ordinance including dissemination of information to the restaurants, hiring a third party to coordinate, enforcing and monitoring the program, the vender permit appeal process, etc.

A **MOTION** TO DIRECT BAXTER & WOODMAN ENGINEERS TO INPUT NUMBERS INTO THE DRAFT ORDINANCE AND DIRECT THE VILLAGE ATTORNEY TO BEGIN REVIEW OF THE DRAFT ORDINANCE was made by Trustee Matuska, seconded by Trustee Abbate. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

The regular Public Works meeting will be September 26, 2013 at 2:00 p.m.

At 3:40 p.m. Trustee Matuska made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Trustee Abbate. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
