51 Commissioner Patel motioned to move from Executive Session back into Regular Session at  
52 4:10 pm. Seconded by Commissioner Carse, the motion carried by voice vote.

54 Commissioners calculated the oral interview scores for the applicants interviewed today. They  
55 then validated the scores of all applicants since all of the applicants have been interviewed. 33  
56 police officer applicants passed both the written exam and oral interview. Discussion took place  
57 about preference points for education or military experience. Commissioner Carse pointed out  
58 that the Rules and Regulations provide for a maximum of 5 preference points to be awarded for  
59 educational achievement of a bachelor’s degree or higher or military experience as stated in  
60 Illinois statute. Since all applicants have at least a bachelor’s degree, the commission decided to  
61 award everyone 5 preference points.

63 The commission established an initial eligibility register consisting of 33 candidates ranked in  
64 order of score. The initial register does not reflect preference points.
