COURT, SOUTH BARRINGTON, ILLINOIS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Plan Commission/Zoning Board of Appeals ("Plan Commission") of the Village of South Barrington, Cook County, Illinois, will hold a public hearing on April 19, 2017, at the South Barrington Village Hall, 30 South Barrington Road, South Barrington, Illinois 60010 commencing at 7:30 p.m., to consider, make recommendations and conduct a public hearing as required by the applicable statutes of the State of Illinois and the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of South Barrington regarding a proposed variation to Subsection D.1., of Section 2.9, entitled "Swimming Pools," of Chapter 2, entitled "General Zoning Provisions," of the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of South Barrington to allow for the construction of a swimming pool farther than twelve feet (12') from the foundation of the residence located at 6 Woodbury Court, South Barrington, Illinois and legally described as follows:

LOT 17 IN CRABTREE TRAILS OF SOUTH BARRINGTON, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THE NORTH HALF OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 42 NORTH, RANGE 9, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

The applicants for the proposed swimming pool variation are Robert & Kacey Rupczynski of 6 Woodbury Court, South Barrington, IL 60010.

Copies of the petition to permit the proposed swimming pool variation will be on file with the Village Clerk and may be inspected during business hours.

All persons present at the public hearing will be afforded an opportunity to be heard. Written comments may be submitted to the attention of the Plan Commission Chairperson, c/o South Barrington Village Hall at the address aforesaid and will be considered if received at least five (5) days prior to the hearing. The Plan Commission reserves the right to continue the public hearing from time to time in accordance with the requirements of the Illinois Open Meetings Act.
