As a courtesy to residents who have sensitive documents to recycle, such as medical records, tax forms, bank statements, etc., the Solid Waste Agency of Cook County continues to provide seasonal Document Destruction Events. Each year, community events run from May through October, and there is no cost for SWANCC residents to participate. South Barrington is a member of SWANCC.

HAVE YOUR ID READY as staff will be checking each vehicle

BRING PAPER IN PAPER SHOPPING BAGS OR REGULAR SIZE FILE BOXES

THERE IS A LIMIT OF SIX paper shopping bags or file-size boxes per vehicle

NO PLASTIC BAGS

NO METAL CLIPS, PLASTIC SLEEVES, FOLDERS, OR BINDERS

FREE OF CONTAMINATION

NO BUSINESS OR INSTITUTIONAL WASTE WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Workers will help take paper out of vehicles and place in tote carts. The documents will then be loaded into a shredding truck on site. The paper will be cross-shredded, baled, and recycled into new paper products. Please note that residents of any SWANCC member community are able to participate in any event, regardless of location. Go to www.swancc.org to check other dates and times. SWANCC communities include: Arlington Heights, Barrington, Buffalo Grove, Elk Grove Village, Evanston, Glencoe, Glenview, Hoffman Estates, Inverness, Kenilworth, Lincolnwood, Morton Grove, Mount Prospect, Niles, Palatine, Park Ridge, Prospect Heights, Rolling Meadows, Skokie, South Barrington, Wheeling, Wilmette, and Winnetka.

According to the Federal Trade Commission, it is estimated that 10 million Americans were victims of identity theft last year, prompting the National Crime Prevention Council (NCPC) in Washington to issue new warnings about safekeeping financial information.
