**CALL TO ORDER**

President McCombie called the meeting to order at 7:36 p.m., and led the room in the Pledge of Allegiance. Also present were Village Administrator Bob Palmer, Engineer Natalie Karney, Finance Officer Michelle Bodie, Deputy Clerk Liz Chabalowski, Police Chief Thomas Roman, Village Attorney Donald Storino and Village Attorney Melissa Wolf.

**CITIZEN COMMENTS/PRESENTATIONS**

President McCombie asked the audience if there were any questions or comments for the Board and Commissioners.

Resident Dave White commented on the difficulty of seeing oncoming traffic at certain stop signs in the Village, particularly at Witt and Penny Roads. Trustee Patel agreed. Administrator Palmer replied that the Village is planning on having trees trimmed, which should help with visibility. In addition, the Building Officer can trim the foliage to improve visibility.

**JOINT MEETING AGENDA ITEMS**

President McCombie opened discussion on revisions to the Rules and Regulations of the Village of South Barrington Board of Police Commissioners.

Police Commission Chairwoman Carse explained some of the proposed changes, as did President McCombie. Trustee Stagno explained the reason for replacing the word “shall” with either “will” or “must” throughout the document, and noted that while the wording could still be cleaner, he recommends passing the revisions tonight and working on edits in the future.

President McCombie asked each Trustee if they had questions or concerns on the proposed changes. She also asked Chairwoman Carse and Commissioner Michonski if they had any additional comments on the revisions.

Chairwoman Carse noted that the Commission is ready to begin testing to replace two Officers that have left the Village. Brief discussion ensued on the components of testing, and the weight given to various aspects. President McCombie told the Commission that the Board appreciates all the time that the Commissioners will be giving to the Village during the Officer interview process.

**SECONDED** by Chairwoman Carse.

There was no further discussion. By unanimous voice vote, the motion carried.

**MOTION to ADJOURN THE MEETING OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS** was made by Commissioner Michonski.

**SECONDED** by Chairwoman Carse.

There was no further discussion. By unanimous voice vote, the motion carried, and the meeting was adjourned at 8:01 p.m.

Commissioner Michonski thanked the Board for arranging joint meetings, and noted that the last joint meeting was very productive with everyone able to participate.

The Village Board continued with their Regular Board meeting.
