### Special Olympics Torch Run 2018 | June 10, 2018 - 8 AM

Officer Ornelas with the South Barrington Police Department will participate in the Special Olympics Torch Run 2018 on Saturday, June 10. The run will begin at the Barrington Hills Police Department at Route 62 and end at Knox Park in McHenry. In total, the run will be 17.80 miles and will include representation from every branch of law enforcement across the state from local police officers to FBI agents. The Flame of Hope will be carried by approximately 3,000 officers nearly 1,500 miles from June 10 through June 15. The Opening Ceremony for the Special Olympics Illinois Summer Games will be held on June 15 in Normal, Illinois. The Torch Run is the single largest year-around fundraising movement benefitting Special Olympics Illinois.
