AGENDA ITEMS

A. Discussion and possible recommendation regarding the Storm Water Subsidy Program.

The Committee discussed the proposed program. Panchal inquired about the division of responsibilities between the Village and the HOA. Mayor McCombie explained that in most cases Cuba Township would be the lower quote for the work to be done. The Committee discussed various locations that had been identified. Mayor McCombie suggested that the program could be open again in the spring to allow the HOAs to go through their budget process. Following further discussion, a motion was made by Panchal to recommend the identified projects to the Village Board for consideration. The motion was seconded by Abbate. On a voice vote the motion was approved unanimously.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor McCombie reported on the status of the Sundance project and the Letter of Credit (LOC). The Village Attorney was recommending replacing the LOC with a bond, but also retaining \$100,000 of the LOC.

STAFF REPORTS

Village Engineer – Karney reported on a proposal to apply the final lift to the Glen 14 subdivision roadway. Karney explained that the remaining lots had been sold and part of the transaction was to do the final paving. Consensus was that the developer should submit a letter to the Village Board, making the request to do the final paving.

Building/Code Enforcement - Murphey reported on a request from 53 Wood Oaks in regard to utility boxes in the front yard. The resident is requesting the utility boxes be relocated from the front yard. Mayor McCombie recommended contacting the HOA on the issue.

Village Administrator - Palmer reported on the proposal for treatment of the Emerald Ash Borer proposal from Affordable Tree Service.
