Mayor McCombie explained that the contract and work proposed was for the foot bridge in the back of Village Hall that was damaged earlier in the year by the tornado that passed through the Village. Frerichs explained that he has been working with the insurance company to settle the damage and completing the necessary repairs. Frerichs explained that several bids were received for the repair work and that All Pro is the lowest bid. Guranovich asked if the insurance funds cover the bridge repair. Frerichs confirmed that the fund would cover the repairs and if repair costs for some reason exceeded the quoted amount, the Village would be seeking additional funds from the insurance company to complete the repair work. Stagno asked about the work to be completed. Frerichs explained that both railings would be removed and replaced.
