CALL TO ORDER

1. Discussion with Cook County EMRS North Regional Coordinator, Dave Olson.

Dave Olson introduced himself and explained his duties with the County and what resources are available to the Village. He explained that Ted Berger is the new Director of the Department as of three weeks ago. Olson went over the Departments role during the Pandemic response as well as during some recent storm situations. An overview of Department facilities and available equipment was given. Trustee Guranovich asked how the Department prioritizes their assistance. Olson responded that they target their resources to the largest population impact. Olson supplied information on the other contacts they have such as with the Salvation Army and the Red Cross. Each of the organizations offer different resources – Red Cross can assist with emergency housing and Salvation Army can supply drinking water. The Committee thanked Olson for his attendance and the information he presented.

2. Administration Consulting Specialist, LLC – Project to Update Emergency Management Plan

Mayor McCombie presented information about Administrative Consulting Specialist, LLC explaining that they specialize in grant writing and can assist on projects such as the Village's Emergency Management Plan.

3. 2022 Emergency Management Plan Update

Palmer provided an "Executive Summary" of the Emergent Management Plan for the Committee to review and comment on. The shorter version focuses on direct contact information.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor McCombie reported on recent water testing results. Trustee Stagno commented that water softeners take care of unwanted minerals and other compounds from residential drinking water. Mayor McCombie commented on the upcoming well testing program.
