CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Stagno called the meeting to order at 2:35 p.m.

MINUTES

Motion was made by Trustee Abbate to approve the minutes from the September 8, 2025, meeting. Seconded by Trustee Kazi. On a voice vote, the motion was approved.

PUBLIC COMMENT

None.

AGENDA ITEMS

1) Administrator Dropka presented a draft ordinance amending the municipal utility tax on natural gas and the reasoning behind needing the modification. Discussion ensued, and Administrator Dropka answered questions that were posed.

Chairman Stagno, called for a motion to send the ordinance to the Village Board with recommended approval. Motion was made by Trustee Kazi, seconded by Trustee Abbate. On a voice vote, the motion was approved unanimously.

2) Administrator Dropka introduced a resolution to enter into an agreement with Northern Illinois Gas Company for the collection of the village's municipal utility tax on natural gas and the reasoning behind needing the resolution. Discussion ensued, and Administrator Dropka answered questions that were posed.

Chairman Stagno called for a motion to send the resolution to the Village Board with recommended approval. Motion was made by Trustee Kazi, seconded by Trustee Abbate. On a voice vote, the motion was approved unanimously.

3) Administrator Dropka presented a draft ordinance amending the number of liquor licenses for the committee's review. Discussion ensued and Administrator Dropka answered questions that were posed.

Chairman Stagno called for a motion to send the ordinance to the Village Board with recommended approval. Motion was made by Trustee Abbate, seconded by Trustee Kazi. On a voice vote, the motion was approved unanimously.

4) Administrator Dropka introduced a draft ordinance amending parts of the village code concerning the village's right of way, and the length of time a building permit is good for. He detailed the reasoning behind needing the modification. Discussion ensued, and Administrator Dropka answered questions that were posed.

Chairman Stagno called for a motion to send the ordinance to the Village Board with recommended approval. Motion was made by Trustee Abbate, seconded by Trustee Kazi. On a voice vote, the motion was approved unanimously.

5) Administrator Dropka presented a resolution to enter into an agreement with Barrington Snow Solutions for snow removal and ice control services for the upcoming winter season. Discussion ensued and Administrator Dropka and Mayor McCombie answered questions that were posed.

Chairman Stagno called for a motion to send the resolution to the Village Board with recommended approval. Motion was made by Trustee Kazi, seconded by Trustee Abbate. On a voice vote, the motion was approved unanimously.

6) Finance Director Frerichs reported on the year-to-date budget to actuals and presented a high-level review on all fund accounts including their revenue and expenses. Discussion ensued, and Director Frerichs answered questions that were posed.

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

Finance Director Wayne Frerichs provided an update regarding the roof. Multiple inspections were completed, and insurance adjusters have been coming out to assess the situation. The village's roof consultant suggested that we get the shingles tested in a laboratory to prove hail damage and then submit the results to the insurance company. It was reported that there was unanimous consent among the Public Works Committee to direct staff to take further action, and to bring the results to their next committee meeting for further review.


There was an announcement made regarding village personnel.
