## **DEMOLITION OF SWIMMING POOL PERMIT**

**SCOPE:** Removal of existing in-ground pool.

### **REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS:**

- Complete unrestricted PDF file permit submittal of all documents to [permits@southbarrington.org](mailto:permits@southbarrington.org)
- Hard copy permit submittal of all documents to include:
  - Permit Application Form ([www.southbarrington.org](http://www.southbarrington.org), Government, Building & Engineering)
  - Copy of pool drawing
  - Plat of survey showing house & pool location
  - As-built septic system plan
  - Written scope of grass restoration (if application)
  - Copy of contract proposal with estimated cost of construction
  - \$ 150.00 Application Fee (no credit cards)
  - \$ 135.00 Deposit toward Plan Review Fee (no credit cards)

Note: Additional Site Engineering Review Fee May Apply at Permit Issuance

### **SCOPE OF WORK:**

Break up concrete bottom of pool. Then break concrete sides of pool and leave concrete debris in bottom. Level with pea gravel. Backfill in with dirt and reestablish grass with sod or seed.

### **SEPTIC FIELD PROTECTION:**

The septic field shall be protected by a 4-foot tall protective fence at all times during demolition to prevent traffic from entering the septic area. **Absolutely no traffic is allowed on the septic field.**

### **PERFORMANCE BOND DEPOSIT:**

A performance bond deposit (cash or check) is required from both the general contractor and the property owner at the time the permit is issued. In the event that damage occurs to village streets, easements, etc. from any construction or landscaping work the deposit will be retained by the Village Treasurer until the problem is resolved to the satisfaction of the Village Building Department.
