South Barrington is an exceptional community, and we are seeking exceptional candidates to join the ranks of the South Barrington Police Department. We hold ourselves to the highest standards and offer the opportunity to become part of a professional organization dedicated to serving our community with honor, integrity, and respect in every situation. Our officers are trusted to uphold the law, build meaningful relationships with residents, and represent the Village with professionalism and pride.

South Barrington is home to several notable destinations, including The Arboretum Lifestyle Shopping Center, a 24-screen AMC Theatre, and Willow Creek Community Church, one of the largest congregations in the United States. The community is also home to Goebbert's Farm and Garden Center, which hosts its popular Fall Festival each year, attracting thousands of visitors and serving as a cherished family tradition. These attractions contribute to a vibrant community that keeps our department actively engaged in service.

The South Barrington Police Department currently consists of 20 full-time police officers, 5 part-time officers, two full-time records clerks, and one full-time administrative assistant. The Village serves a population of 5,077 residents within approximately eight square miles and operates as a home-rule community.

Village ordinance requires that all applicants be certified police officers in good standing, as recognized by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board under Section 8.1 of the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/8.1), and must meet the following additional requirements:

- Currently working as a full-time police officer for an Illinois law enforcement agency; or
- Retired as a full-time officer from an Illinois law enforcement agency; or,
- Laid off as a full-time officer from an Illinois law enforcement agency.

Requirements:

- At least 21 years old
- United States citizen
- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university OR an Honorable Discharge from the United States Military
- Valid driver's license
- At least two (2) years of experience as a full-time sworn, certified law enforcement officer with an Illinois law enforcement agency
- State of Illinois certification by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board



Salary and Benefits:

- Entry level Officer salary is **\$78,090** but based on experience the Lateral Officer Salary could be increased to **\$100,412** (Contract expired April 2026, in negotiations).
- Comprehensive benefit package including BlueCross BlueShield Illinois healthcare plans (HMO and PPO available), Dental, and Life Insurance
- Flexible spending account, deferred compensation plans, and an employee assistance program are also available
- Eighty (80) hours of vacation
- Ninety-six (96) Holiday hours banked at the beginning of each fiscal year
- Ninety-six (96) hours of sick time annually
- All uniforms, equipment, and body armor are provided except firearms
- Patrol Officers rotate between day, and night shift every three months on a 12-hour schedule with seven workdays and seven days off every two weeks, having Friday, Saturday, and Sunday off every other weekend

4. Copy of your college or university degree (A sealed and certified transcript of your course work will be required for background investigation)
5. Copy of your valid driver's license
6. Copy of your U.S. Military DD-214 form, if applicable
7. If applicable, a copy of your certificate of completion of Illinois Basic Law Enforcement Academy training or comparable training from another state
